WATERING DAYS

ODD numbered address → **WEDNESDAY SUNDAY**

EVEN numbered address → **TUESDAY SATURDAY**

No watering between the hours of: 9:00am and 7:00pm

As of June 1, 2016, a new watering schedule is now in effect. The new schedule prohibits watering between the hours of 9am and 7pm, Sunday through Saturday. Watering days remain the same, with odd addresses allowed to water on Wednesday and Sunday. Even addresses are allowed to water on Tuesday and Saturday. RECYCLED WATER FILL STATION NOW OPEN TO AUTHORIZED USERS

The City of Turlock is offering recycled water to residents and businesses in and around the City of Turlock. Recycled water is available for limited commercial users as well as residential customers for landscape irrigation. Recycled water is available to AUTHORIZED users through a self-serve drive through system. Those interested in utilizing recycled water must complete an online certification program and submit a certificate of completion, along with a completed application to the City of Turlock Municipal Services Department at 156 S. Broadway, Ste. 270, Turlock. Approved applicants will receive an identification card and

appropriate labels for user supplied recycled water containers that must be properly labeled. Turlock's recycled water is offered free for residential users and for commercial users at a nominal fee. For more information, visit www.CityofTurlock.org.



MANY BUSINESSES NOW REQUIRED TO SEPARATE FOOD WASTE

The State of California recently enacted AB 1826, which requires businesses and multifamily residences that generate specified amounts of waste to arrange for recycling services for organic waste by April 1st, 2016. Organic material, as defined by the State, includes: food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper. Gardening or landscaping service offered to those businesses in the above categories are also subject to this law and businesses must ensure that this organic waste is recycled. Multifamily residences are only required to arrange for recycling services for green waste. The City of

Turlock and Turlock Scavenger Company have services available to assist businesses and multi-family



residences to be fully compliant. For commercial businesses who do not currently subscribe to organic (garden) refuse disposal service, but meet the threshold for service requirement, contact Turlock Scavenger Company immediately at (209) 668-7274 to arrange for organic recycling service.

The City's previous garden refuse collection service, which is collected in the residential green cart, is now the City's organic collection service and should be utilized for disposal of garden refuse and organic material.
