

**“QUALITY SERVICE THROUGH TEAMWORK”**

**Residential Water Audit Program**

This City-wide program is offered free-of-charge to single-family and multifamily (up to eight units) water customers who pay their water bills to the City of Turlock. As part of this program, a Water Conservation Representative will tour your property to identify leaks and water-saving opportunities.

Participants can receive water-saving equipment including low-flow showerheads, faucet aerators and other free items. The Representative will also evaluate your landscape and irrigation systems. Since this program emphasizes customer education, it is important the tenant/occupant be present at the time of the survey.

**During the home water survey, the water**



**conservation specialist will:**

- Provide useful conservation tips to help you manage your water use.
- Inspect irrigation stations, and provide a checklist of suggested improvements.
- Provide irrigation scheduling information to assist you with programming your timer.
- Check for signs of leaks
- Demonstrate how to read your water meter and use it to monitor your use.
- Provide high-efficiency showerheads and kitchen faucet aerators, if needed.

This free service is offered to City of Turlock customers.

**Only Rain Down the Drain**

Water that flows off our yards, streets, parking lots and driveways into storm drains eventually ends up in the San Joaquin River. The storm drain system and sewer system are completely separate. Our storm drains transport water untreated to City storm ponds where it eventually percolates back into the ground, or is pumped to an irrigation canal and ends up in the San Joaquin River. As water makes its way to storm catch basins it picks up and takes with it all the pollutants found on City streets, sidewalks, gutters, driveways and parking lots. Did you know that dumping just one

quart of motor oil down the storm drain could pollute 250,000 gallons of water?

**Help us reduce pollution in the San Joaquin River by doing the following:**

- ◆ Comply with the City landscape watering schedule
- ◆ Don’t overuse fertilizers or pesticides
- ◆ Pick up your pet’s waste
- ◆ Sweep up yard debris into green container
- ◆ Call 668-5590 to report any illegal dumping
