Officers administered life-saving measures until Fire and AMR paramedics arrived on scene and relieved them. Tragically, one victim was pronounced deceased at the scene, while the second was promptly transported to Doctors Medical Center for treatment. Additional

resources responded to the scene to provide assistance with the ongoing investigation, which is currently being handled by the General Investigations Unit.
