SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

The shift was busy and filled with good police work by dayshift officers. A female was contacted and determined to have a warrant out of CSUS for drug possession charges. She was arrested and cited. Officers contacted a group of homeless subjects and determined one male had a felony warrant for his arrest for hit and run charges. He was booked. Officers investigated a theft of a bag containing personal items from a woman loading her groceries in her car at a grocery store parking lot. The suspects drove by and one reached out of the car and stole the bag from her. We are working on identifying the suspects. Officers located a stolen vehicle parked. They observed a male get in the driver seat of the vehicle and quickly swooped in to arrest him. He was found to have a warrant for his arrest along with drugs in his possession. He was booked for multiple charges. An officer located a vehicle being driven by a male who was wanted for assault with a deadly weapon. The male pulled over and was arrested/booked. Shortly after this, another officer stopped a car being driven by a male who had a warrant for felony vandalism. He was booked. At the end of our day, a suspect in a serious felony domestic violence case returned to the victim's apartment trying to force his way into the apartment. When officers arrived he fled in a vehicle and a pursuit ensued. He was pursued to Patterson where Stan SO assisted in deploying spike strips to disable his vehicle. He gave up and was arrested. He was booked for multiple domestic violence charges, including assault with a deadly weapon, false imprisonment, and criminal threats, along with felony fleeing, vehicle theft, and drug charges. Other than this it was a peaceful day.

SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

During the pursuit of the suspect mentioned above, other officers responded to a security check of an older male who lived alone. Family members had called to report they had not heard from him in several days and they did not have access into his house. When officers arrived they checked the backyard and could see the male laying down and unresponsive through a window. Officers had to breach the front door and found the male still alive with feces around him. AMR was called and transported the male to the hospital. Officers responded to an assault & battery in-progress between two males. When the first officer arrived on scene the suspect vehicle had just fled the area. Other officers BOL'd and located the vehicle being driven on the road. A traffic stop was made and three occupants inside were detained. The victim of the battery did not want to pursue charges, but the driver, and suspect of the battery, was determined to be DUI and was arrested for that.
