SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

The shift was busy and involved several arrests. Officers located a stolen vehicle after receiving an alert from a law enforcement database. The vehicle was parked and unoccupied. Officers began canvassing the area for a possible suspect. During the search, a resident advised officers that a subject was in their backyard. Officers checked the area and discovered the suspect had fled over a fence into a neighboring yard. Officers established a perimeter, and the suspect was later located hiding inside a shed with the assistance of a UAS (drone). K9 announcements were made and the suspect surrendered without incident. The suspect was identified as the driver of the stolen vehicle and was found to have multiple outstanding warrants for his arrest. Officers later responded to a trespassing complaint at a business. Officers contacted the suspect inside and he refused to comply with the officers' orders. The suspect was taken into custody and during an arrest search a loaded firearm was located concealed on his person. Suspect was arrested for several felony charges related to the possession of the firearm.
