SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Steady shift throughout the night. During this shift officers responded to a violation of court order and later located the suspect. He was arrested and booked into jail due to the restraining order being issued for domestic violence. Officers contacted two suspicious people during a call for service. During a search of one of them narcotics were located. Based on his prior convictions the possession was a felony and he was booked into jail. Officers contacted a subject during a possible burglary call. During the initial contact the subject attempted to avoid officers and lied about his name while providing a real person's information. He was arrested for resisting and false impersonation of another. At the jail his true identity was determined which revealed he had a felony warrant for stalking. Officers investigated a domestic battery incident where a female was arrested for assaulting a male. She was booked into jail.
