This project will rehabilitate the corridor of West Main Street from Lander Avenue to a point between Walnut Avenue and Kilroy Avenue. Bulb-outs will be installed to provide shorter crossings for pedestrians.

Improvements at Denair and Hawkeye



This project installs a new traffic signal at the intersection of Denair and Hawkeye along with related improvements to support the traffic signal. This project leveraged Measure L dollars to compete for Federal funds.
