


# City of Turlock 2023 Newsletter



### Keep Organic Waste Out of the Landfill

California State Law (SB 1383) and City Municipal Code now require residents to separate their organic waste (yard waste like grass clippings, leaves, branches and food waste) from their regular garbage. Keeping organics out of the landfill reduces methane emissions. Turlock Scavenger utilizes the 3 cart system to make achieving these goals easily. Separate your trash according the carts color: Blue for recycling, Green for organic and black for your remaining household waste. Graphics are now on the carts to show examples of what should be placed and should not be placed into the containers. ## Christmas Tree Pick Up

Turlock Scavenger provides a free pick up of Christmas Trees immediately after the Holidays. Between December 26th through January 31st place your tree out at the gutter near your carts the night before your pick up day. Turlock Scavenger will be out with a separate truck to remove your tree. Please make sure your tree is free of all ornaments, garlands, and other decorations. This service is for <u>LIVE TREES ONLY</u> and does not apply to artificial trees.

- A) Turlock Scavenger will be servicing the normal Thursday Route.
- B) Turlock Scavenger will be servicing the normal Friday Route.

# City Leaf Pick Up

Residents are encouraged to use their green waste containers for leaves and garden refuse. Any leaves that will not fit in to the green container may be placed in the street 18" from the curb side in loose piles, not bagged. Limbs are not to be placed in leaf piles. Do not park vehicles in front of your residence in locations which will prevent access to leaf collection prior to your scheduled day, on the scheduled day and the day after your scheduled day. This will allow for more flexibility within the schedule.
