WHAT DOES A 32% REDUCTION IN WATER USE LOOK LIKE?

For the first time in California's history, the Governor has directed the State Water Resources Control Board to implement mandatory water reductions in cities and towns across the State. Using 2013 water use as the benchmark, the Executive Order imposes a 32% reduction in total

water use for the City of Turlock in 2015

To assist customers with conservation efforts, the chart to the right provides information on the average per person water use in Turlock for 2013. The third column displays the number of gallons that would equal a 32% reduction in water use. The five columns to the right display the 2015 target household water use

The City of Turlock has a year round water conservation program, based on an odd/even watering schedule. City staff responds to complaints regarding water wasting. Seasonally, staff patrols all neighborhoods in Turlock to educate consumers about water conservation. On June 26, 2015 the City of Turlock implemented Stage 2 Mandatory Conservation Compliance Measures city wide. Outdoor landscape watering is now restricted to two days per week throughout the City of Turlock, as shown in the image to the left.
