SPECIAL DEPLOYMENT EFFORTS:

1. Coffee with the Chief, April 28, 2018—Chief Amirfar hosted another Coffee with the Chief event. This event is open to the community to come and address any questions or concerns they have about Turlock directly with the Chief of Police.
2. Every 15 Minutes, April 12, 2018—Police staff, along with TUSD and CHP coordinated the Every 15 Minutes event for Pitman High School seniors and juniors about the reality of drinking and driving.
3. During the month of April, the Traffic Safety Unit completed the following operations as a requirement of the STEP grant: a driver enforcement overtime detail, two DUI saturation details and a general traffic enforcement overtime detail.
4. In April, 12 Downtown Overtime Extra Patrol shifts were worked. Officers are allowed to sign-up to work non-mandatable overtime shifts to provide extra patrols, specifically to downtown and city parks to address City Ordinance issues, illegal nuisance behaviors, and other criminal violations.
5. Daily, the Traffic Safety Unit patrols school areas during morning and afternoon traffic for extra traffic enforcement to ensure the safety of students.

ANIMAL SERVICES & PET OF THE MONTH:

1. During March, Animal Services Officers visited 326 residents for pet license enforcement.




Part One Crimes YTD 2018 vs YTD 2017
