



SPECIAL DEPLOYMENT EFFORTS:

- 1. Coffee with the Chief, August 11, 2018—Chief Amirfar hosted another Coffee with the Chief event. This event is open to the community to come and address any questions or concerns they have about Turlock directly with the Chief of Police.
- 2. National Night Out 2018—On August 7, 2018, the Turlock Police Department participated in the 35th annual National Night Out with Turlock residents. This year, there were 29 registered block parties that participated, totaling in approximately 2,000 participants.
- 3. Downtown Extra Patrol Shifts are a non-mandatable, voluntary overtime detail. Officers that sign up are tasked with providing extra patrols of the downtown area and city parks nearby. Officers are to conduct patrol on foot, bike or Trikke. Officers are encouraged to conduct outreach with business owners, network and collaborate with them to address CTO's, illegal nuisance behaviors and other criminal violations by applying the Community Oriented Policing philosophy. Officers are encouraged to sign up to work for two to four (2-4) hour shifts anytime between 0700-1700 hours, Monday through Friday. During the month of August, 3 extra shifts were worked.
- 4. TPD Lip Sync Video— The department released their very own Lip Sync Challenge video after weeks of citizens asking if we were going to participate. As of 9/14/18, there 28,218 total views on YouTube. (<u>https://youtu.be/TJv2gCBNNTY</u>)




