**SPECIAL NOTE:**

The COVID-19 pandemic has greatly impacted the Turlock Police Department’s reductions shown in this report. COVID-19 forced businesses to close and social gatherings to stop, resulting in reductions of calls for service, police reports, officers’ self initiated activity, traffic collisions, arrests, crime rate, etc., during the months March through December; however, violent crime, such as aggravated assault and homicide rates, have increased when compared to 2019.

**COPS GRANT:**

In December 2020, Council voted and accepted the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Grant, which will assist with the hiring of 4 additional police officers. This grant increases our allocated number of police officer positions from 78 to 82, which increases our ratio of full-time police officers to 1.11 per 1,000 residents.
